6. Cemetery Information and Policies Document

After reviewing updates and edits to the newly renamed Cemetery Information and Policies, Chris made a motion to accept the revised document. Mary seconded. The revised Cemetery Information and Policies was unanimously approved by voice vote.

7. Tin Sign

Established 1871, is the proposed wording for a tin sign that will hang from the Elmwood gate by chains and act as a height marker to help protect the scrollwork. The trustees like the idea of an oval sign with white lettering on a black field, with a white oval outline. A place in southern NH can make one for under \$100, and the plan is to purchase 2 and place them back-to-back. Mary will ask Tim Greene of StandFast Works Forge for his thoughts on the sign and seek his assistance with placement and installation.

8. Water Blowout near Elmwood Gate

An additional set of bollards (3 sets total) would protect the water spigot/blowout.

A sign on the righthand bollard could read:

Historic Iron Gate

Circa 1914

Large vehicles use back gate at end of Dow Ave

9. Plague to honor Barabara Holt

The trustees will pursue the idea of placing a plaque on the crypt, shed or golf cart

Nellie Phillips 1864-1935 has a Women's Auxiliary marker, but is not on flag list
Some of the more recent burials of the past few years need to be added to the list of Veterans
