TRUSTEES OF TRUST FUNDS

March 20, 2024

In attendance: Jan Cole, Karen Foss, Carol Walker & Mike Betley

The meeting commenced at 4:07 pm.

<u>Transactions for February 2024</u>: There were no transactions in February for either the Capital Reserve Fund (CRF) or the Common Trust Funt (CTF).

The Trustees reviewed the <u>February 1-29, 2024 Three Bearings/Fidelity Common Capital Reserve Fund</u> (CRF) report with a beginning balance of \$2,879,098.66 on 2/1/2024. There was an increase of \$8,575.93 in the CRF investment value during the month that resulted in an ending account value \$2,887,674.59 as of 2/29/2024. On a year-to-date basis, the CRF investment value has increased by \$23,598.41. Dividend income for February 2024 was \$6,385.70.

The Trustees reviewed the <u>February 1-29, 2024 Three Bearings/Fidelity Common Trust Fund</u> (CTF) report with a beginning balance of \$323,982.33 on 2/1/2024. There was a \$150.86 increase in investment value in the CTF during the month that resulted in an ending account value of \$324,133.19 as of 2/29/2024. On a year-to-date basis, the CTF investment value has decreased by \$173.39. Dividend income for February was \$618.91.

Three Bearing's quarterly portfolio management fees of \$3,201.02 for the CRF and \$359.31 for the CTF for the period from 12/1/23 to 2/29/24 are accounted for on an accrual basis and reflected on the MS-9 in February 2024 (net of dividends earned during the month for the CRF and the CTF) even though the transactions are not paid until March 2024 per the Fidelity brokerage accounts. Dividends earned of \$6,385.70 less the CRF portfolio management fee of \$3,201.02 resulted in net income in the CRF of \$3,184.68 in February 2024. Similarly, dividends earned of \$618.91 less the CTF portfolio management fee of \$359.31 resulted in net income in the CTF of \$259.60 in February 2024.

The MS-9 for the period from 2/01/2024 through 2/29/2024 was reviewed.

Portfolio X-Ray reports dated January 31, 2024 for our CRF and CTF portfolios were provided by Zackary Zwick at Three Bearings for the Trustees' review. Carol circulated a "Using the Portfolio X-Ray Report" guide.

<u>Minutes</u>: Draft minutes for the February 22, 2024 Trustee meeting were reviewed. Karen made a motion to approve the minutes with several corrections; Jan seconded her motion. All voted in favor of the motion to accept the minutes with the corrections. Carol will send the final approved minutes for February's meeting to the Town Administrator and Secretary for posting to the Town's website.

Other business:

Following the February meeting, Carol_forwarded a copy of that meeting's draft minutes to Linda Lambert at Three Bearings so it could be uploaded with our MS-9 and MS-10 documents. Karen successfully submitted Franconia's 2024 MS-9 & MS-10 documents through the New Hampshire Trustees of Trust Funds Portal on 2/29/24. NHDOJ will review the submitted ledger; Karen has since received notification that the review was completed and accepted.

Jan shared a memo she sent to the BOS regarding an old outstanding reimbursement item related to the Cemetery Maintenance Fund that dates back to 2021. Since requests for confirmation and documentation have gone unanswered, the Trustees consider this matter to be closed based on the lack of response over an extended period of time.

Jan circulated a final <u>2024 Warrant Articles & Funding worksheet</u> based on the warrant articles that were approved at Franconia's March 12, 2024 Town Meeting.

Jan noted that she will work with Libby to make sure the \$36,260.00 transfer from the Unassigned Fund Balance is made to the applicable Trustee accounts within 10 days of the Annual Meeting.

<u>Town Reimbursement Requests for 2024</u>: There has been no change to last month's 2024 Pending Reimbursements ledger that is current through 3/15/2024 and has been attached to these minutes. The document includes initial amounts, descriptions, fund source and information needed in order to process requests for reimbursement. Jan will work with Libby to process reimbursement for the heating system at the Transfer Station. Those related to the new fire truck will take place closer to its arrival scheduled for June.

<u>Scholarship</u>(s): With the end of school approaching, the Trustees agreed that based on 2023's earnings in the Franconia Scholarship Trust account, the total Scholarship amount will be \$5,000.00 and the Towse Athletic Award will be \$100.00 for a total of \$5,100.00. She will send an email to the Scholarship Advisory Committee members (Tom Allen, Anne Steuernagel and Jane Brewer) so they have sufficient time to solicit scholarship applications and prepare a recommendation so we can review it at our May 15, 2024 meeting. She will include Jill Brewer, Profile High School Counselor, who usually coordinates the applications with Franconia students and suggests an athlete for the Towse award.

Diana Young from Three Bearings asked the Trustees to update their contact information and return the sheets to her. Jan collected them to send to Diana.

There being no further business, the trustees adjourned the meeting at 5:25 pm. The next Trustee meeting will be on <u>Wed, April 17, 2024</u> at Town Hall beginning at 4 pm.
