Final Minutes

TRUSTEES OF TRUST FUNDS

May 15, 2024

In attendance: Jan Cole, Karen Foss, Mike Betley & Carol Walker

The meeting commenced at 4:00 pm.

<u>Transactions for April 2024</u>: CRF activity in April includes a deposit of \$36,260.00 from the Unassigned Fund Balance (UFB) consisting of \$2,000.00 for the Town Building Maintenance Fund, \$260.00 for the Highway Heavy Equipment Fund, and \$34,000.00 for the Highway Department Truck Fund; there was a \$20.00 transaction fee. The CTF had no activity to report in April.

The Trustees reviewed the <u>April 1-30, 2024 Three Bearings/Fidelity Common Capital Reserve Fund</u> (CRF) report with a beginning balance of \$2,991,351.05 on 4/1/2024. With the deposit of \$36,260.00 more than offsetting the \$20.00 transaction fee and the negative change in investment value of -\$32,446.07, there was a net increase of \$3,793.93 in the CRF account value during the month resulting in an ending account value of \$2,915,144.98 at 4/30/2024. On a year-to-date basis, the CRF investment value has increased by \$18,029.82. Dividend income for April 2024 was \$7,522.20.

We called Three Bearings and spoke with Zachary Zwick, CFP, after noticing that the CRF portfolio had more than usual sale and reinvestment activity than usual in the past month. He explained that software used to track our portfolio had indicated Franconia's funds invested were outside of the target allocations; when this occurs, Three Bearings will make changes to bring it back into target based on our portfolio investment policy. We discussed the following: upcoming funding needed for the fire truck and other disbursements in the next 90 days, whether we should ask them to notify us in the future prior to re-balancing, and should a re-alignment be only for invested funds net of money market account balances held for purchases in the next 90 days.

The Trustees reviewed the <u>April 1-30, 2024 Three Bearings/Fidelity Common Trust Fund</u> (CTF) report with a beginning balance of \$331,130.43 on 4/1/2024. April's decrease in investment value of -\$8,354.11 resulted in the ending CTF account value of \$322,776.32 as of 4/30/2024. On a year-to-date basis, the CTF investment value has decreased by \$1,170.95. Dividend income for April 2024 was \$849.65.

The MS-9 for the period from 4/01/2024 through 4/30/2024 was reviewed.

The Trustees reviewed Three Bearings' Quarterly Portfolio Review effective 3/31/24 for the CRF and the CTF as well as an annual update of Three Bearings Firm Brochure and its Privacy Policy.

<u>Minutes</u>: Draft minutes for the April 17, 2024 Trustee meeting were reviewed. Karen made a motion to approve the minutes with minor corrections; Jan seconded her motion. All voted in favor of the motion to accept the minutes with minor corrections. Carol will send the final approved minutes for April's meeting to the Town Administrator and Secretary for posting to the Town's website.

Other business:

<u>Municipal training</u>: 2024 Municipal Trustees Training will be held June 13, 2024 in Concord with a Zoom option. Jan and Carol will be able to take advantage of the training through the Zoom option.

<u>Town Reimbursement Requests for 2024</u>: Jan updated the Pending Reimbursements ledger through 5/15/2024 which is attached to these minutes. She will work with Libby to process the various reimbursements.

<u>Scholarship</u>(s): The Scholarship Advisory committee received applications from Avery Gignac and Bode DeMarzio, both qualified applicants. Tom Allen, the committee's representative, joined the trustees at the start of our meeting to share the committee's recommendation. Based on the Advisory Committee's recommendation, the Trustees voted to award a Franconia Scholarship of \$5,000.00 to Avery Gignac and the Towse Athletic award of \$100.00 to Bode DeMarzio. Bode is the class of 2024's Valedictorian and Avery is a co-Salutatorian. Jan will provide procedures to Jill Brewer from Profile High School for Avery Gignac so that the check can be issued promptly.

Layette Regional School's (LRS) annual Lucy Pfosi Award: Meaghan Caron, Secretary of LRS requested \$200 from the Lucy Pfosi Memorial Trust Fund to be awarded to a student "who demonstrates the highest degree of social responsibility by being a positive leader who helps others be successful". The Town will write the check and make it available to be picked up.

There being no further business, the trustees adjourned the meeting at 5:45 pm. The next Trustee meeting will be on <u>Wed, June 26, 2024</u> at Town Hall beginning at 4 pm.
